We are happy to present the Jewish calendar for the upcoming year: 5784.

This year is unique because it is a Jewish leap year. Instead of the usual 12 months, 5784 contains 13 months.

What does this tell us?

The Rebbe spoke to this topic and gave us an incredible insight, "One point, which cannot be overemphasized, is particularly relevant at this time of year. It has to do with the Torah's concept of time.

We add this extra month in the calendar so as not to fall behind in the seasons of the year and to celebrate Sukkot in the harvest season and Pesach in the spring, being that the lunar calendar on a regular year lags behind.

"While the Ibbur (leap) year is a recurring phenomenon involving highly intricate calculations, and details that affect Jewish life in totality, it also provides a simple object lesson. Every Jew has been endowed with the capacity to recoup and complete those "lost" days which, for one

another, have not been fully utilized in terms of Judaism, Torah and Mitzvos.

"This means, in effect, that a Jew has the spiritual strength to be a "master over time." Indeed, a Jew can gain mastery over time not only in terms of the present and the future, by setting for themselves the highest standards of conduct, but they can also rectify their past."


What an incredible year lies ahead of us!





Across the world, millions of women and girls are lighting candles 18 minutes before sunset on a Friday afternoon, ushering in peace and blessings, their collective power of light transforming the world. When there seems to be an avalanche of darkness in the world, Shabbos candles provide illumination and clarity. The acronym for the Hebrew words Neirot Shabbat Kodesh (Shabbat candles) is NeShek, which means ammunition. Shabbat candles are the ultimate ammunition in the global fight against evil, suffering, and darkness.

This week, commit to lighting candles 18 minutes before sunset just this week or this month. Or for every week from now on. Ensure you are lighting them at the correct time or encourage a friend to join you in this sacred mitzvah.

TEFILLIN

This daily reunion with G-d is the ultimate opportunity to align your heart, mind and actions. These black leather boxes contain parchment scrolls with texts from the Torah discussing the unity of G-d, a fundamental idea in Jewish faith. One box is placed on the arm nearest the heart, the seat of the emotions, and the leather strap is wound around the left arm and hand. The other box is placed on the forehead, teaching us to dedicate ourselves to the service of G-d in all that we think, feel and do. Once the Tefillin are placed on your arm and forehead, it is customary to recite the Shema Prayer.

Consider committing to putting on tefillin once, twice or three times a week. Already committed to putting on Tefillin, think about making it a daily (excluding Shabbat and festivals) activity. Carry a pair of tefillin with you, always ready to offer another Jew the opportunity to perform this transformative mitzvah.



Inside the powerful Shema prayer is inscribed, on the outside, a name for G-d. A Mezuzah reminds us that this is a home for G-d. In Judaism, spirituality is not confined to the synagogue services. Instead, every part of our lives should be imbued with holiness and meaning. Relaxing in the living room, dinner around the kitchen table, the morning rush, all our potential opportunities to connect with the divine. Every time we pass through a door, pause, look up, give a kiss and take a moment to celebrate your relationship with G-d.

Contact your Rabbi today to affix a mezuzah to every door in your home. Check your Mezuzahs regularly with a scribe to ensure no letters have become smudged or erased. Encourage friends and family to hang mezuzot in their homes. Donate to a fund to gift mezuzot to those who cannot afford it.



LIGHT A CANDLE - SAY A PRAYER - SHARE THE LIGHT



(1) HOW TO FRIDAYLIGHT It starts with one light. Add a candle for your soul mate, and if you are a mother, one for each child. A girl over the age of three may (with help from Mom) light her own candle.

Before kindling the candles (18 minutes before sundown), we think of those less fortunate and put a coin in a charity box.

(2) LIGHT A CANDLE Once the candles are lit, close your eyes, and with your hands gently moving above the flames, sweep the warmth towards your eyes three times.

Then, placing your hands over your eyes, honor the divine spiritual connection of lighting Shabbat candles by speaking the Hebrew blessing that women across the globe have said for thousands of years.

(3) THE BLESSING Hebrew: Boruch. A-toh Ado-noi E-lo-hei-nu Me-lech Ho-olom A-sher Ki-de-sha-nu Be-mitz-vo-sov Vi-tzi-vonu Le-had-lik Ner Shel Shabbat Ko-desh. English: Blessed are You, Lord, our G-d, King of the Universe, who sanctifies us with His commandments, and enjoins us to light the candles of Shabbat.

(4) SAY A PRAYER This is the moment to pray for yourself, your loved ones, and all the world. As you uncover your eyes, feel the candle's glow seep through every cell of your being, ushering in a moment of inner peace.

(5) SHARE THE LIGHT Picture millions of women around the world lighting FridayLight candles. Picture the peace of Shabbat radiating across the globe.

CLASSIC CHICKEN SOUP

- 5 Carrots, peeled and chopped
- 2 Zucchini, cut into chunks
- 1 Onion, peeled
- 1 Sweet Potato, peeled

- 1 Bunch Fresh Dill
- 2 Chicken Drumsticks, bone in, without skin
- 1/2-1 Tablespoons Salt, to taste

Put carrots, zucchini, onion, sweet potato, dill and chicken in a 8 or 10 quart pot with water to fill the pot. Bring to boil and then lower to low-medium flame for 2 hours. Bring to a simmer for an additional hour. Add the salt, tasting as you add. Serve hot and enjoy! (Freezer pro-tip: remove all the vegetables and freeze broth in freezer safe containers.)

BUTTERNUT SQUASH SOUP

- 1 Butternut Squash, peeled and roughly chopped
- 3 Carrots, peeled and chopped
- 1 Onion, sliced

- 5 Cloves of Garlic
- 1 Tablespoon Oil
- Water
- · Salt. to taste

Heat pot with oil and onion and allow to soften and become translucent. Add in garlic cloves and saute for 2 minutes until fragrant. Add in the carrots and butternut squash and fill to just about cover. Bring to a boil and lower to a low flame for approximately 1 hour, until all the vegetables have softened.

Using an immersion blender, blend everything together. (To keep it chunkier, blend for just a minute) Add salt while still hot and serve.

NON-DAIRY CREAMY ZUCCHINI SOUP

- 5-6 Zucchini, washed and chopped
- 1 Onion, sliced
- 5 Cloves of Garlic

- 1 Tablespoon Oil
- Water
- Salt, to taste

Heat pot with oil and onion and allow to soften and become translucent. Add in garlic cloves and saute for 2 minutes until fragrant. Add in the zucchini and fill with water 3/4 of the way on top of the vegetables. Bring to a boil and lower to a low flame for approximately 1 hour, until all the vegetables have softened. Using an immersion blender, blend everything together. The longer you blend it for, the creamier it will become. Add salt while still hot and serve.
